The 2024H1 release is only available for cloud customers right now. If you have additional questions about a feature, please contact your account representative or email [Journyx Support](#).


Modern Search Experience for Management Screens

The 2024H1 release has a bunch of goodness for the power users who manage information in the Journyx system week in, week out. In recent releases we have focused on the user experience for time entry users, supervisors doing approvals and business analysts running reports. In this release, Journyx delivers an easier and more modern user experience for those who manage users, projects, and other information in the Journyx system.


New Look and Placement for Buttons/Actions on Management Screens

The 2024H1 release also includes new look and placement for management screen buttons and actions. All buttons and actions are now at the top of search and modify screens, and new icons are activated based on applicable selections.

New Reporting Features for Journeyx PX

Two standard report types for Journeyx PX, *Billable Forecast* and *Utilization/Chargeability*, now include the option to add visual charts as part of the report output and for consumption on the dashboard. There is also a new daily resource allocation feed that allows you to look at the total hours for a resource broken out by category and summarized by period. The categories include project assignments, unassigned hours, predefined overhead hours, leave and holiday time.
