Accessing New Features

This guide includes descriptions of new features in Journyx and Journyx PX version 13.4.0 (2025H1) and is intended for existing Journyx customers who are upgrading to the 2025H1 release from Journyx 13.3.x (2024H2). If you are upgrading from an earlier version, you will also need the guides for earlier versions.

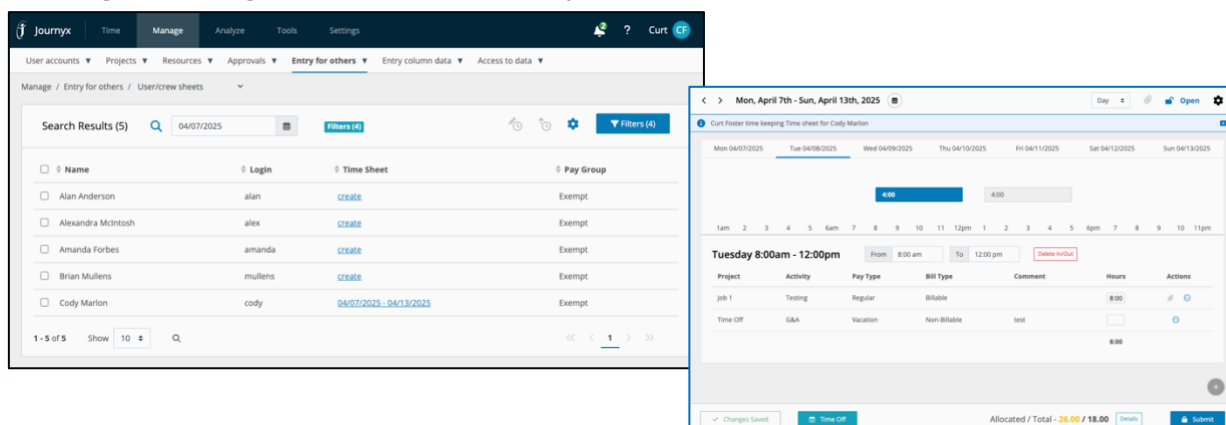

Timekeeping Interface Upgrade with Supervisor Job Start/Stop Management

In the 2025H1 release, Journyx has updated the main timekeeping (entry for others, user/crew sheets) management screen to include all the features available on our other modern management screens. This update also allowed us to improve the interface for managing edits to job screens for time entry users who have to track job start/stop times on a job entry screen.

You can review the updates to the timekeeping screen here: **Manage**→**Entry for others**→**User/crew sheets**. You can now configure which fields will appear in the search results by clicking on the gear icon, and there is a quick date search available by clicking on the magnifying glass at the top. Like other updated management screens, you can customize the search filters that will be remembered from session to session. Icons at the top allow you to edit and/or submit a list of selected sheets. Color coding and tool tips help with identifying sheets in different states.

The updated timekeeping screen also includes the ability for those with timekeeping abilities to see and edit job start/stop times on job entry screens. If the timekeeper is entering time on behalf of a user with a job entry screen, the timekeeper will be able to edit existing times or add “missed punches” where a user might have forgotten to clock in or out of job work.

Optional Geolocation Tracking for Time Entry Users

The 2025H1 release also includes a new option to turn on location tracking for users assigned to a time entry screen with location tracking turned on. You can make it optional or required. You can track based on browser entry or mobile*.

You can set up a specific time entry screen to track location for users assigned to it by going to **Settings**→**Customize entry screens**→**Time entry screens** and clicking on a time entry screen name to edit the settings. Geofencing options will be in available in the 2025H2 release in October.

When a user has location tracking turned on, geolocation information will be appended to time entries. You can access this information and view the location on a map by clicking on the paper clip icon next to the entries or clicking on the linked information in list reports.

*New mobile releases will be available in May and June for location tracking.

Accrual Improvements for More Precise Point-in-Time Balance Reporting

Journeyx JX includes basic accrual balance management, with options to add more complex handling via the Accrual Calculator add-on and specialty tools offered by Journeyx Professional Services.

As part of the 2025H1 release, Journeyx has included some additional details to basic accrual event logs that allow standard accrual reporting and auditing to sort accrual events in a logical order and display more accurate balance totals for any specific point in time. While the basic accrual features aren't designed to capture a full history, the improvements to accrual event tracking allow you to get more granular information in your spot reporting for accruals while using the only the basic accrual features.

Cloud-to-Cloud Integration and Dynamics 365 Finance (F&O) – Version 2

In addition to the robust .NET-based ERP integrations Journeyx provides for its customers (a/k/a “Accountlink”), the 2024H2 release included a new option to handle all of your Journeyx-ERP integration management directly in Journeyx with cloud-to-cloud integration. Like Accountlink before it, access to the cloud integration options requires a special license key.

The Journeyx cloud integration framework includes our first standard integration for Dynamics 365 Finance (F&O). Like other ERP integrations with Journeyx, you can run a sync to pull all of your business data (e.g., employees, projects, earning codes) into Journeyx and start tracking time. When time is

approved, in version 2 you can send it back to F&O to update the booked hours for project journals based on the data mappings established in the business data sync.

Accountlink versions for Business Central, Intacct, and NetSuite will be ported to the cloud framework so that they can be managed directly in Journyx. Watch for future product announcements that indicate when these ERPs will be available in the cloud framework.
